Issues proposed to be raised on appeal, including jurisdictional challenges: This interlocutory appeal from the district court's granting of plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction raises numerous issues, including: whether and to what extent the First Amendment applies to the conduct regulated by the state of Florida under the state law challenged in this case; if the First Amendment applies, what level of scrutiny should the court apply to evaluate the challenged provision in this case; under the relevant level of scrutiny, is the challenged provision a permissible regulation; whether the challenged provision is a permissible regulation under the dormant Commerce Clause; and to what extent was the district court's order granting plaintiffs' motion an otherwise proper use of its equitable power.
